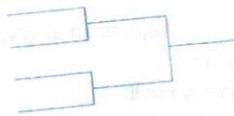

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Texas Tenpin Bowling Association Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. The tournament will be sanctioned through United States Bowling Congress (USBC) and will be conducted under the rules and regulations of this organization.
2. All entries must be sent to the Tournament Manager no later than February 1, 2022. All entries postmarked the first post office business day following the entry closing date shall be accepted. Tournament Director reserves the right to accept applications up to 30 minutes before squad time.
3. Entry fees must accompany application and no fees shall be refunded except when an entry is rejected or a bowler rejects an average rating. Each club shall issue one check to Texas Ten Pin Bowling Association to cover all entry fees from their club.

4. Only bowlers who are affiliated with member clubs of the Texas Ten Pin Bowling Association shall participate.
5. All entrants must be current members of USBC. If not, bowlers may purchase a USBC affiliated member card. Each member must display their membership card when they check in.
6. Divisions and Averages Classifications:

7. Bowlers may compete twice in the Team & Doubles Events, but only once in the Singles Event. For Example: Men's/Mixed or Women's/Mixed. Your first set in any event counts toward your All-Events score. Doubles will be bowled 1st & Singles will be bowled 2nd.
8. Handicap: The handicap for all participants will be computed on the basis of 90% of 220.
9. Individual Average Verification Process
 - A. Entering Average of ALL bowlers shall be their highest 2020/2021 Fall/Winter USBC sanctioned league book average with a minimum of 21 games.
 - B. Bowlers not falling within the above will use their highest certified league average of 21 games or more for the current 2021 Summer Season with the league secretary's written verification.
 - C. Those not having the above average will use their highest USBC sanctioned league average of 21 games or more from the 2021-2022 Fall/Winter season as of January 31, 2022 with the league secretary's written verification.
 - D. Bowlers not meeting one or more of the above average requirements, will bowl scratch.
 - E. All averages must be certified by the Club Tournament Entry Form Chairperson.
 - F. **USBC Rule 319d applies.** This rule specifies that any contestant who has won \$300.00 or more in any event in a tournament in the last 12 months must report their actual score, position and amount won to the Tournament Manager at the time of the entry for possible re-rating. If a bowler's average is re-rated; it must be done before they bowl, and if re-rated average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded.
 - G. Each bowler is responsible for verifying the accuracy of their average. Failure to use proper average shall disqualify a score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winning shall be based on the bowlers submitted average if it higher than the actual average. In the case of two or more bowlers, the average shall be combined to determine whether the correct total is higher or lower than the submitted total. Corrections can be made prior to the completion of the first game of series, or within 48 hours after completion, if the Tournament Manager consents to such in writing prior to the completion of the first game.
 - H. Rule 319a: item 2, 10 or more pin increase in average and Rule 319e, 15 or more pins increase in average are waived.
10. Prize Fund Money: All prize fund money will be returned 100% at a ratio of at least 1:6 in Team, Doubles and Singles Events and a ratio of at least 1:20 for All Events.
11. Unlimited substitutions may be made. When a substitute's average places a team in a different class than the original entry, the entry shall bowl in the reclassified class, in which case prize fund money shall be distributed to reflect the actual number of participants. All substitutions must be reported by club representatives to the Tournament Manager at least 2 days in advance of bowling. In case of emergency, notification must be made at least one-half hour in advance. Changes may be made by calling the Tournament Manager.
12. In the event of ties for First Place, duplicate trophies will be awarded to the winners in All Events.
13. ALL BOWLERS MUST BE 18 YEARS OR OLDER in age.
14. Bowlers arriving late will start in the frame in progress and will receive zero for all frames missed.
15. Bowlers are required to check in at the Tournament Office/Table 30 minutes prior to the beginning of practice.
16. ALL changes need to be addressed before tournament scheduled weekend except for last minute emergencies.
17. In no instance shall a bowler roll all nine (9) games on the same pair of lanes.
18. Participants shall hold harmless Texas Tenpin Association, officers, tournament managers and bowling center in event of accident or emergency.
19. In the event of an Act of God and the tournament has to terminate early all prizes will be paid out based on participation as of that date.
